

2010 OPERATING RULES for the Tilt Farmers' Market

The South Whidbey Farmers' Market will operate:

Saturday 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. from May 1 through October 9.

1. All vendors must have completed the vendor application and will be assigned a space.
2. Vendors are requested to arrive at least a half an hour before opening and stay to the end of market.
3. Vendors who cannot attend a market day **are requested to contact the market manager.**
4. All vendors must comply with all local, county and state regulations, including, if selling prepared food, obtaining a Food Handlers' Permit and filing a Farmers' Market Food Vendor application with Island County Health Department.
5. All vendors are encouraged to have a sign displaying their company names at their selling spaces. Produce vendors should include their growing practices, e.g. certified organic, without pesticides, sustainably grown, etc. A physical barrier must exist between certified organic and other products.
6. We request that vendors not sell to the public before the 10 a.m. opening.
7. Out of county crops and any crafts must be pre-approved by the market manager on duty.
8. Any accident or injury must be immediately reported to the market manager, first aid kit in Laughing Cat.
9. Any vendor who wishes to erect a canopy or umbrella on the farmers' market site must have it securely anchored to the ground and removed at the end of the day. Refer to "Selling spaces" in policy, page 1
10. All children and pets (dogs) must be supervised by a responsible adult.. No smoking in the market area.
11. If there are any complaints or questions, please contact the market manager on duty.
